Republican Nominees:

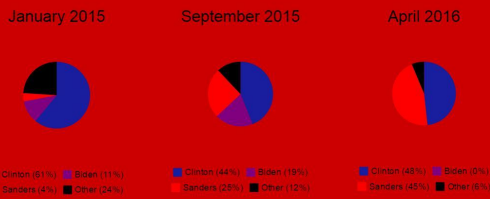
- Donald Trump** - Trump stands firm on his position on severely limiting immigration. Additionally, he is pro-life and pro-gun rights. He supports a strong, military-led foreign policy paid for by lower taxes.
- Ted Cruz** - Cruz supports a strong border security policy and limited, controlled immigration. He is pro-life as well as supportive of gun rights. He supports a larger military to enforce a strong American presence overseas. Cruz has proposed a simple flat tax that would abolish the IRS.
- John Kasich** - Kasich does not support the deportation or penalization of immigrants. He sees abortion as reasonable in certain defined situations. He supports a more neutral US presence abroad, as well as lower taxes.

Democratic Nominees:

- Hillary Clinton** - Clinton supports a comprehensive citizenship process for illegal immigrants. She supports abortion and limited gun rights. Central to her campaign is large military and a strong foreign policy. Clinton's campaign wishes to expand taxes on the rich and reduce them on the poor.
- Bernie Sanders** - Sanders supports a path to citizenship for illegal immigrants. He supports abortion as well as limited gun rights and a smaller, more cost-effective military. Sanders supports a tax reform that raises taxes at all levels to create more government services for the poor and the common citizen, including free college and expanded welfare.

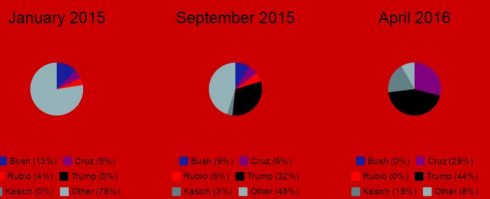
